stroke for better speed. The perfect "Line" is no good if you can't control the distance. See John Ward or Scott at Citrus National for a series of drills to improve distance control and start making more putts.



The pickleball net line is painted on the east side and the west side of the hitting area. When the sun is rising in the morning, use the west wall. When the sun is setting, use the east side. This way, the sun will be behind you, so you do not have to look into the sun while you are practicing.

Targets have been put in place for hitting volleys when you are up close to the wall. There is a big red circle for groundstrokes when you are further back in the court. The color system goes along with Judy's teaching zones on the tennis court. Her students are loving it! Rob Pridgen said he has been enjoying the target shoot as well!

Our intention is to resurface both sides of the playing surfaces on the hitting wall this fall.




