out of the sand bunker and onto the green. Just do two things: Hit the sand approximately one inch behind the ball and follow through. That's it. Do this fearlessly and with a little practice, most people will become good bunker players. Simple enough? After a little practice, see John Ward or Scott in the Golf Shop to get this shot fine-tuned. Then Practice.





Fried Pickles and Cooked Tennis Players

The summer heat is upon us. Intrepid members are still coming to the courts and participating in the sports that they love. We have another 11 to 12 weeks of heat to weather before we get that nice cool breath of air.

Guest FEE Confusion????

Guest fees apply to Pickleball, Tennis, Swimming Pool, Fitness area and all aspects of Oak Village Sports Complex. And it is very simple.

If your guest lives within a 40 mile radius of Oak Village, they are limited to 6 visits a year and must pay a \$15.00 guest fee each time they visit. Simply contact Robin Frick and register your guest. She will then charge the guest fee to your account.

If your guest is "visiting" from a distant location, there is no guest fee required. Visiting means exactly that... Not staying or living with you.

All Non-members that are not registered are being asked to leave the property and to consider purchasing a membership for future club use.

The guest fee is there to protect your investment. Please abide by the Guest Fee Rules.

Let's Play Pickleball

By now you've certainly heard of Pickleball. Pickleball is the fastest growing sport in the U.S. for the third year running with 36.5+ million players and is gaining popularity across the world. It is so popular because it is an incredibly accessible sport that is easy to play and is popular across all age groups. Pickleball is an easy sport to get into because players are generally open to beginners, it doesn't take a large investment to get going, and it is a fun and social sport.

So, how do I get started in Pickleball? It's good if you can find a partner to begin your journey into Pickleball, but not absolutely necessary. Once you get out to the courts, you will quickly meet other players and beginners like yourself. So to get started, we'll have to get the basic equipment, take some lessons, and then just start playing. Members of the Oak Village Sports Complex (OVSC) have 8 beautiful Pickleball Courts, a certified instructor that provides group or individual lessons, and 3 groups that you can play with to learn the game and advance your skills.

What equipment do I need to begin my journey into Pickleball? You'll need to acquire shoes, a paddle, and a few pickleballs to get going. While each of these items can be expensive, you really don't need the top-of-the-line equipment to get going. As you gain experience, you'll be able to upgrade your equipment as you like.

Start with a good pair of outdoor court shoes. There are a lot of choices for pickleball specific shoes and

while you could shop online, you really should try them on to experience the fit and support they provide. Also, while Pickleball shoes are specifically designed for the quick and nearly constant lateral motions, you can begin your journey with any court shoe designed for tennis or basketball. Leave your walking shoes, running shoes, and cross trainers off the court, however. They are designed to support forward motion, not side-to-side with quick starts and stops.

Next, you'll need a paddle. As you might imagine, there are many paddles available in all price ranges and features. As a beginner, you will not need to buy top-of-the-line paddles, but stay away from the Amazon cheapies as well. As your game develops, you'll learn more about what your paddle is good at and not-so-good at. You can find very good, well priced paddles online at Friday Pickleball, Carbon Pickle, and Luzz Pickleball, or talk to our certified coach, Judy Jeanette, when you take your lessons. She can usually get you a good deal.

Now, all we need is a pickleball. There are several brands and types of pickleballs to choose from but stay away from the cheap off-brands. They won't play well and you'll be replacing them early and often. At OVSC, the Franklin X-40 ball is very popular and works well. You can buy them in 3-packs, 12-packs, 36-packs, and 100-packs.

Ok, so now that we have our new equipment, let's head out to the courts and take a few lessons. We have a very good instructor that provides individual and/or group lessons. The group lessons are on Friday mornings at 10:30AM. They are fun, informative and will allow you to meet other players. Show up at the courts on Friday at 10:30AM or call Judy Jeanette at 352-232-0321.

Once you have a lesson or two behind you, you can show up and play with one or more of the Pickleball groups. We have 3 established groups of pickleball players at OVSC that you can join, depending on your level and time preferences. And although each group meets three times a week, you can pick and choose when you want to attend. Two of the groups are open to beginners and one is for more advanced play.

The groups are:

Pickleball Day Dinkers Late Mornings

The Day Dinkers are a group that caters to beginners. They try to work on specific skills during games and keep you from feeling overwhelmed. The Day Dinkers meet on Fridays at 11:30AM, immediately after Judy's

lesson and again on Wednesday and Sunday at 10:00AM.

Pickleball FAMILY FUN Mornings

This is a low keyed "play for fun group", welcomes newbies and non-bangers to join their FAMILY. The FAMILY is made up of members that feel like...well...."FAMILY".
