Golf Tip of the Month

Here's a backswing tip that could make a big difference in your game. Try visualizing and feeling the knuckles of your left hand passing over the shoelaces of your right foot during your takeaway. While we usually avoid focusing too much on specific positions in the swing, this tip can help many golfers. As you practice this, notice how your hip sway diminishes. Your hips will naturally shift back, and your swing will take on a more rounded shape, which is a good thing. Also, when you take the club straight back or slightly outside the target line, shoulder turn is almost nonexistent. "Knuckles over Shoelaces" could be the key to turning your game around.
