Golf Tip of the month: It couldn't be a more simple task as to always check your alignment. So many swing errors can come from poor alignment. Is your buddy telling you that you keep "coming over the top"? Well, if you are aimed thirty yards right of the target, you better "come over the top" or that ball is going way right. Alignment sticks help and they are provided at the range. We often see shoulders wide open/aimed way left at address. This can also create quite a mess. Feet, hips and shoulders should be aligned parallel to

your target line. Exceptions may be made for physical limitations or even if you've always played that way. Here's the tip: Ask John at Citrus or Tim or Eric at Sugarmill to check your alignment. It should only take a couple of minutes. Let's make 2025 your best year ever!

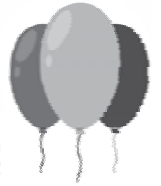

Weed free in 2025 is our new year's resolution. 2024 was the year we knocked out the goosegrass and 2025 is when the pre-emerge herbicide will keep those nasty weeds off our course. Winter projects include lots of tree work. Country Club Quality is the goal.

I'd like to thank my whole crew for their dedicated team effort these last several months. We do take great pride in Sugarmill Woods CC. "It's more than just a job".

As growing season starts, we will be adding a couple of operators to keep up with the mowing. We see all the signs that this grass will explode this summer. Steady progress now and then look out. You won't recognize Citrus come next fall.

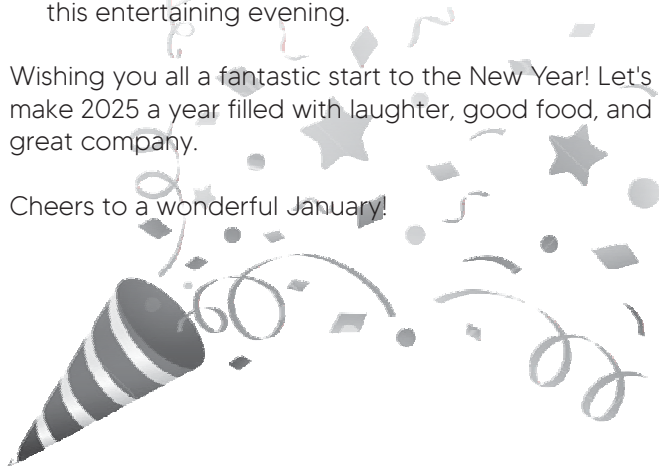

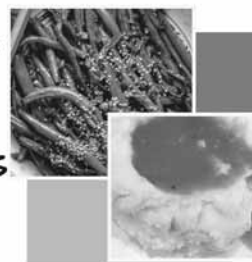

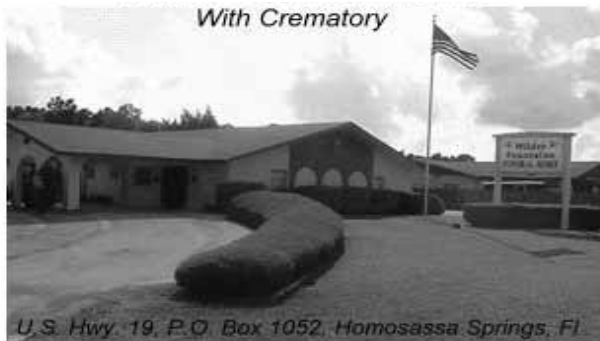

Welcoming the New Year with the Bubbly



although the word has become generic and the wine an icon of celebration.

If you are celebrating the New Year with the bubbly, choose the right bottle and the right glass.

For the glass, choose a perfectly clean crystal, either a flute (tall and thin with a long stem) or a tulip (a wider base with stem). Hold the glass by the stem to avoid transferring heat from your hands to the wine.

Bottle size matters. A standard bottle will give about 5 glasses. A larger bottle, say a Magnum, gives about 12 glasses. For big parties and dramatic displays, champagnes come in all sorts of sizes. The Jeroboam has the equivalent of four standard bottles, or 24 flutes of champagne, according to Pepites-en-champagne.

Still larger, the Rehoboam contains 6 bottles or 36 flutes. The dramatic Methuselah contains 8 bottles or 48 flutes. One of the largest bottles is the Melchiesedech, which contains 40 bottles, or 240 flutes.

Interestingly, the larger bottles are said to provide a more flavorful sparkling wine.

It is said that about 1680 in a French monastery Dom Perignon made a great discovery. He called to his fellow monks, "Come quickly! I am drinking stars!"

The spirited exclamation may well be more of a 17th century advertising slogan instead of an actual event, but it does describe the experience of sparkling wine. Developed over the centuries in the Champagne region of France, only sparkling wine from that region can properly be called Champagne,
