

Hole in One Club

Your clubs offer two Hole in One Clubs. The Citrus HIO is only for aces made at Citrus National GC and Sugarmill HIO is only for aces made at Sugarmill Woods CC. Each time a hole in one is made by someone in the HIO Club, "the pot" is put into that player's Credit Book. This is used for the Bar tab and whatever is left, if any, stays in that person's credit book.

Then the Credit Book is replenished by charging everyone in the HIO Club \$2. Some people call this insurance to handle what can be a large bar tab. Sign up today with Eric at Sugarmill Woods or John Ward at Citrus National. Then go make an ACE!!

Golf Tip of the Month

Short game, short game, short game. To shoot lowers scores, reduce that handicap, and win more chits, get more efficient around the greens. "The quality of your short game determines how low your good scores can be." See one of our golf professionals and start some friendly competitions around the green. Closest to the hole, "21" or how many putts can you make in a row from 4 feet? Get really good at any 6 foot putt, then stroke a putt from that spot to win the Masters. Only the last putt counts. Challenge yourself and make it feel like the real thing. Efficiency around the greens lowers scores.

At **Citrus National**, the foundation for a full-scale turf recovery has been laid. In past years, ineffective practices often led to watering and fertilizing weeds rather than turfgrass. That's no longer the case. With **water management under control** and **weed eradication well underway**, we're now seeing the benefits-water and nutrients are finally going where they belong: into healthy turf growth.

Recently, **#2 green was resodded** and is now rolling beautifully. We've also begun addressing some of the most worn-out tee boxes, starting with **#10 tee**, which has seen excellent progress following a fresh sod installation.

Looking ahead, members should anticipate **temporary course closures** as we implement aggressive **summer maintenance**, including **Deep Tine aerification**—a much-needed process. While it may temporarily affect aesthetics, it's essential for long-term health and playability. **We're treating this summer as a full-scale grow-in**, and it's already yielding visible improvements.

We encourage members to observe our progress firsthand-feel free to drive the course using the **cart paths**. You may also encounter **occasional cart path-only holes** during key maintenance phases. Please help us by adhering to the paths for the entirety of those holes. We'll do our best to keep restrictions minimal.

Our mantra this summer is **"Good to Great"**, and the momentum is building.

As Scott always says, "It's happening." And we couldn't agree more.
