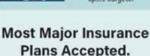

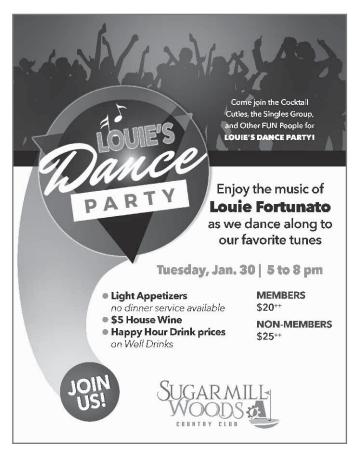
Featuring nationally touring stand-up comedian, Juanita Lolita, this night promises to redefine comedy with a clean and hilarious twist

#### **Golf Tip of the Month**

A slice is the most common fault I see among students. This is caused by the clubface being open at impact. One way to ensure the clubface is square at impact is to strengthen your grip. No, I don't mean hold it tighter. I mean to position your hands more to the right or clockwise (left or counterclockwise for a left-handed player). The V's that are formed between your thumbs and index fingers should point to your right shoulder

(left shoulder for a left-handed player). Get in front of a mirror and look where your V's are pointing. If they are pointing in the correct place, this minor change will greatly reduce your slice.

Do You Have a Pickleball Workout?

#### **Hey fellow picklers!**

Pickleball combines several elements from tennis, badminton and ping pong and has rapidly gained popularity as a competitive sport for people of all ages. Whether a beginner or a seasoned veteran, structured workouts that focus on strength and conditioning help you increase power, reaction time and agility. So, who would not want improvement in any of the aforementioned categories? Unfortunately, most rec players do not warm up prior to playing and they do not follow a planned exercise routine to help prevent injury. That may be why the injury statistics are rising for pickleball players.

### Some of the most common injuries in Pickleball include the following:

**Sprained Ankle:** One of the most common injuries in pickleball. Quick lateral movements, sudden stops and changes in direction strain the ankles and makes them more susceptible to twists and sprains.

**Tennis Elbow:** Also called lateral epicondylitis is another common ailment among pickleball players. Repetitive gripping and swinging motions cause strain on the tendons of the forearm.

**Shoulder Injuries:** Without the proper technique and conditioning, overhead smashes can lead to shoulder injuries such as rotator cuff tears and strains. Exercising to improve the mechanics of the shoulder joint enhances shoulder stability and mobility.

**Lower Back Pain:** There are dynamic movements in pickleball that can result in lower back pain. Exercises that target the core muscles and promote good posture creates stability of the spine and makes it less likely that lower back pain will occur.

**Knee Strains:** Quick changes in direction and repetition of movements can initiate knee strains. In pickleball, lateral movements and sudden stops can stress the knee joints. Strengthening these muscles provides better support of the knee joint and reduces the risk of strains and overuse injuries.

**Hamstring Strains:** The running, lunging and quick stops put the hamstrings at risk of a strain. Proper conditioning of the hamstrings helps players maintain

control during fast movements and reduce the possibility of painful strains.

**Achilles Tendonitis:** Explosive movements and quick changes of direction in pickleball can create inflammation in the Achilles. Even jumping and landing awkwardly can result in an Achilles issue. Exercises that strengthen the calf muscles help prevent strain on the Achilles tendons.

**Wrist Strain:** Pickleball involves a lot of wrist movement for precise shot delivery. Overuse of the wrist can lead to strain and discomfort. Developing wrist strength and mobility can help players develop proper wrist positioning which reduces strain risk and enhances shot accuracy.

Pickleball is an exciting and dynamic sport, however like any other sport, injuries do happen and can quickly halt any progress you may have made during your learning experience. Proactive steps to help prevent sprains, strains and overuse injuries include strengthening and flexibility exercises, using proper technique, and following an overall body conditioning workout.

**SAMPLE WORKOUT BELOW:** To reduce the likelihood of injuries, strength training, increasing flexibility through stretching and balance exercises are essential. All of the exercises below help prevent strains, sprains, and other common injuries.

**Warm Up:** A warm up is crucial to prevent injuries and prepare your muscles for any ensuing activity. Light cardio for 5 to 10 minutes should be sufficient to get the juices flowing. Cycling or jumping jacks followed by dynamic stretches that target legs, shoulders, and core should be sufficient.

**Strength:** Focus on upper and lower body and incorporate the following strength exercises into your routine

- Squats: Increases leg muscle strength. Strong quadriceps and glutes are essential for quick movements on the court.
- Lunges: Improves balance and stability while strengthening lower body muscles.
- Push Ups: Strengthens your chest, shoulders, and triceps to achieve more powerful shots.

Do You Have a Pickleball Workout?

- Plank: Engages core muscles to improve stability and endurance during matches.
- Rows: Strengthens the upper back and improves posture. This results in better control and shot accuracy.

**Cardiovasculer:** Pickleball is fast-paced and requires good cardiovascular endurance. Any exercise that increases the heart rate is sufficient.

- Interval Training: Alternate hi-intensity with short rest periods. This could be as simple as running at full speed for 3 minutes and then walking for 1 minute.
- Cycling: Improves cardio health and builds leg strength.
- Stair Climbing: This activity mimics the quick lateral movement needed to play pickleball.

**Agility and Footwork:** Agility and footwork are key to success when playing pickleball. Drills that increase speed, agility and reaction time are of paramount importance.

- Ladder Drills: The drill improves footwork, coordination and quickness.
- Cone Drills: Set up various patterns with cones and move between them to improve quickness.
- Side Shuffles: Duplicates your crab walk at the kitchen line (NVZ) and quickens your movement side to side.

**Rest and Recovery:** Work hard during your pickleball workouts, but also allow your body to rest. Rest is important for muscle repair and growth. Adequate sleep, proper hydration, and a balanced diet will contribute to your recovery and performance.

By following a comprehensive pickleball workout plan, you will be on your way to improving your game and your fitness level. Pay attention to how your body responds to your workout. Begin at a suitable level and progressively increase the intensity and duration. Be consistent and stick to your routine; you will be sure to reap the rewards on and off the court.

Stay Healthy. Active and On Top of Your Game!

Beginner players and those just learning the game, stop by the courts Monday, Wednesday and Friday between 7:00AM and 9:00AM. Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday are open play days for more established players from 8:00AM until everyone is too tired to continue.

We use an App called Spond to communicate extra pickleball events above and beyond scheduled play time. If you are interested in being included in these notifications, contact Karen Huber-Leinweber and you will be sent an invitation to join. #### OAK VILLAGE SPORTS COMPLEX

#### **Exciting Things are Happening....**

#### **Positive Changes for 2024**

The new year rings in changes to our lives. One positive improvement for the Oak Village Sports Complex is the new reservation system to help manage the tennis and pickleball courts. The swimming pool and other amenities of Oak Village will also be monitored in the same way.

With the snowbirds back and leagues and activities increasing, the use of the Oak Village Sports Complex is hopping. The following guidelines will help manage Oak Village and protect your memberships.

This system will be put into place on January 8, 2024.

Please review it and get into the habit of reserving courts and registering all non-member guests.

### Oak Village Sports Complex Tennis and Pickleball Court Reservations

- A tennis or pickleball court may be reserved up to fourteen (14) days in advance. No court reservations may be scheduled in consecutive time periods by the same member, family, or group. The maximum number of courts that may be reserved by a single member is two (2). Cancellations should be made as soon as possible. Failure to show up within 10 minutes of your reserved time will result in forfeiture of that reservation.
- Doubles may reserve no more than a 2 hour block of time. Doubles are two players on each side. It can also be Canadian/Australian/Cut Throat doubles, which are two on one side and one on the other side.
- Singles, one on each side, may reserve no more than a 1 hour segment of time.
- All reservations need to start on either the full hour or the hour.
- Reservations have preference at all times. Players not having reservations must give way promptly to those who do.
- A member with or without a reservation, who has not played, has priority over members who have already completed their reservation play time.

- All authorized club mixers, tournaments, special events and Club leagues, have priority over general play. These events will be scheduled and posted.
- SMW has set aside courts at the Oak Village Sports Complex for the teaching professional. The tennis and pickleball staff professional has exclusive rights to all instruction.
- All forms of organized tennis or pickleball play must first be approved by the Oak Village Manager and/or Director of Tennis and Pickleball.
- The court reservation sheets will be clearly posted on a board found on the blue counter inside the Oak Village Office/Fitness area.

#### **How to Make a Court Reservation:**

The Reservation Board will house the reservation sheets. This board can be found on top of the blue counter in the Oak Village office/fitness area.

- Place an "X" across the time and court you wish to reserve.
- Circle your name to indicate that you take responsibility for the reservation.
- Write in each player's name in that section. All names must be actual players. You may not reserve a court using "not for certain" players. In other words, all players listed must be available to play.
- Cancel your reservation if you find you will not be playing.

## Oak Village Sports Complex Guest Policy The Guest Policy will apply to all areas of the Oak Village Sports Complex.

#### **Definition:**

**House Guest:** Those visiting temporarily and staying over night at a member's home. No guest fee charge.

**Local Guest:** Those living within a 40-mile radius of SMW. \$15 daily guest fee charge.

**Distant Guest:** Those that reside more than 40 miles from SMW. No guest fee charge.

Each member is required to register any and all guests and pay the necessary fees. Members will be charged a daily fee of \$15.00 (including the tax) for each LOCAL guest. This fee enables the guest to participate in all

activities at the Oak Village Club for the day. The fee may be billed to your account or the guest may pay cash for the day.

To register your guest, you must contact the Oak Village Manager, Resident Professional or inform staff/representatives that are on site. You must provide the complete name and city of your guest. If your guest is not registered, your membership account will automatically be billed for the guest(s) fee(s).

The sponsoring member is required to accompany his/her guest(s) and is responsible for their conduct.

Local guests at this time have no limit to the number of times they will be allowed to use the Oak Village Sports Complex during the year.

#### **Brushing the Courts**

Thanks to all the players who have been remembering to brush the courts after play. Hopefully, it's starting to become routine to do so.

Just a reminder to please brush the complete court surface. First do the perimeter making sure to touch the fence/brick line and bottom of the net. Then fill in the middle. Completely brushing the entire surface displaces weed seeds and discourages the growth of algae and mold. Be creative in filling in the middle. Different directions of brushing are encouraged. Circles, north to south, east to west or even diagonal helps keep the court surface more level. So be creative and let your inner Salvador Dali run wild!

#### **Women's Doubles Flex League**

Are there women players interested in participating in a doubles flex league? All the women tennis members are welcome to join, no matter your rating. The league can be set up either rotating the person you play with against another team or having a set partner with whom you play against other teams.

We would start the league in January, playing one match per week according to a schedule. Each team

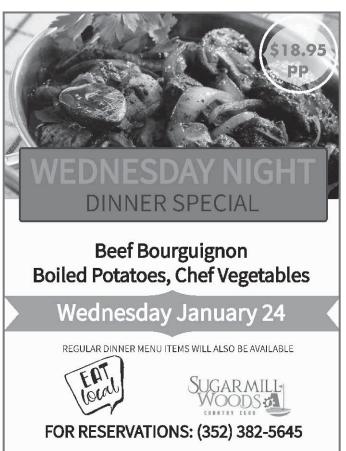
