

Golf Tip of the Month: Make More Putts

Putting is often the quickest way to lower your scores—but are you practicing it the right way? Many golfers focus too much on line, and not enough on **speed**. Worse, they "practice missing" instead of "practicing making" putts.

This month, try working on 3-4 footers, uphill and downhill, left and right breaks. See the ball go in. Hear that perfect sound of the ball dropping into the cup. Play putting games. Start friendly competitions.





Summer Tennis Camps, Classes and Drills

Tennis Camps and Classes

Mini Pea Tennis (Ages 5 to 9) will continue to meet every Wednesday, 5PM to 6PM. The fee is \$15 per visit per student. Meeting dates are as follows: May 7, 14, 21, May 28, June 4, 11, No class on June 18, June 25, No class on July 2, July 9, 16, 23, 30, August 6, 13 and continues through the school year.

Yellow Pea Tennis (Ages 9 to High School Intermediate Players)

This will continue to meet every Tuesday, 6 to 7:30PM. The fee is \$25 per visit per student. Meeting dates are as follows: May 6, No Class on May 13 and 20, June 3, 10, No class on June 17, June 24, No class on July 1, 8, 15, July 22, 29, August 5, 12 and continues through the school year.

Tournament PREP CAMP (All ages of Juniors and includes Active Adults)

This class is for those more advanced players that compete on teams, leagues and/or tournaments. The camp will run the week of June 16, 17, 18, 19 and 20 and we have June 21 reserved for rain make up hours. Camp will run from 5 to 9PM each night. The camp is 20 hours of concentrated practice with instruction and coaching. Pre-registration is required. The fee is \$400 for the pre-paid week, \$135 per day. Bonus classes during class week included are Super Drill meeting (Monday 9 to 11AM) and Doubles Clinic on Friday mornings 8:30 to 10:30AM.

Weekly Tennis Classes and Drills

Super Drill for All Ages

This active and intense workout meets twice a week every week throughout the year. Everyone warms up with the usual forehand, backhand....and then things really start moving with game based drills. Players should be able to keep the ball in play. This drill is recommended for USTA 3.0+ rated players and above. Age is not a factor. We have AARP passes that will be given to our older players. The drill meets Monday

mornings from 9 to 11AM and Wednesday evenings from 6 to 8PM. The fee is \$20 per visit. The date in the summer that **we will NOT meet is: July 2.**

Doubles Strategy Clinic....Percentage Tennis

This clinic works on playing doubles with your partner as a team. You will be drawing tips from the likes of the Bryan brothers, Martina Navratilova, Gigi Fernandez, the Woody's and McEnroe, to mention a few. You will be learning the difference between two singles players on the court together versus playing doubles with communication and complimenting movement. If you don't like playing the net, you may choose to stay home. This class will teach you to be aggressive and attack the net. You will learn to serve and move in, return and move in. You will learn how to play different game styles and win. We practice with a purpose. The fee for this class is \$20 per visit.

The dates in the summer that we will NOT meet are: May 8, 16, 23, July 4, 11.

Pickleball Stroke of the Week Clinic

This is a weekly pickleball clinic that meets every Friday from 10:30 to 11:30AM at the Oak Village Sports Complex on Pickleball courts #1 and #2. Beginners to intermediate level players attend to work on skills and tactics that help improve their playing abilities. If you are interested in improving your forehand, backhand, dink, 3rd shot drop, volley, overhead, spins, control, power, strategies, team work and movement, rules, scoring, equipment....we cover it all. Every lesson finishes with supervised game play. The fee to attend each week is \$15.00 per player.

Reservations are not necessary. For more information you may contact Judy at 352-232-0321. Judy is a double certified, RSPA and IPTPA pickleball professional.

Automatically Reserved Pickleball Courts

Courts #1 - #6 are automatically reserved for the following groups at their designated times. Courts #7 and #8 are always available for members' private play. If courts #7 - #8 are not reserved, then morning group overflow play may use the open courts.


