Golf Tip of the Month

July's golf tip of the month is **LOVE** your swing and find YOUR RHTHYM to let it work. We all attempt to copy swing positions of our favorite player. Position to position to position like connect the dots is how we try to improve. Suppose you simply accepted your natural swing and added a smooth cadence to "your" move. Start with a waltz and 1-2-3, 1-2-3, 1-2-3 contacting the ball on count 3. We've heard many times, it's all about the timing. Find your personal swing's "Timing". A famous tour player once named his backswing "all the way back". If you can say "all the way back" on your backswing, you probably have a smooth backswing. Pick your favorite tour player's swing and say their first name on the backswing and last name on the followthrough. Two syllables on the way back and one through impact. Tiger....Woods or Scottie...Scheffler could be what leads you to that smooth rhythm. Go find your timing, not someone else's positions.

We need to also thank all who have embraced our Red Flag program. Keeping carts on the paths until reaching the Red Flag is minimizing cart traffic on the Bermuda grass. Nice start!






