

Weight will be on your lead foot/left foot for right-handed golfers. Hold that finish for 3 seconds while watching your ball sail through the air. Even if you hit a bad shot, you will look good doing it.

LINKS GOLF SUPERINTENDENT

We have found the secret sauce for our back nine greens. Sugarmill Woods will see this winter, why we have Zoysia grassed greens. As they continue to mature, the move to all Zoysia greens could happen by next summer. As cooler temperatures arrive, even freezing, note how green Zoysia stays all winter. Zoysia is extremely resistant to weeds and has no problem with shade.

- Pre-emergent herbicide went down last month to stop weeds from returning.
- Motors and pumps are all working 100%.
- Timers are being replaced so that system will run on a program
- Roughs and tree areas all mowed and being maintained.
- Weekly Foliar greens application starts early this month
- Andy Woods is inspiring his team at Sugarmill with attention to detail.

The Citrus National team is finding their stride, and we are super happy with the greens progress. Jason Sanders loves his spray rig and so does the grass. We are ready for season.
