

A quick reminder that reservations are essential. They help us provide smooth, attentive service and ensure your dining experience is exactly what you expect.



Golf Tip of the month

“A good chipper and putter is a match for anyone” Ben Hogan

Have you been chunking or skulling your chip shots? Solid contact is the key to controlling trajectory and distance of your shots around the greens. Would you like my twenty-seven detailed instructions on how to be a better chipper or a quick and simple one size fits all tip?

“HEARD” Here's your tip of the month.

Address the ball with 70% of your weight on your left foot (right handed golfer) and shoulders level/parallel to the ground. This is critical as usually your right shoulder is lower than your left. Then finish swing with your chest facing the target. Boom, you are now a better chipper and will start lowering scores today.

Please see me for your next 30-minute chipping session to make sure it's correct. Let's get that chipping game fixed asap.

“We do hard things” continues to inspire the crew every day. Late January and early February gave us frost delays and dormant turfgrass. We've endured droughts, hurricanes, turfgrass diseases, equipment breakdowns and a few issues that we can't discuss. The crew keeps moving forward, with the goal of making both courses the best in the Nature Coast Region.

With the warmer temperatures, look for increased aerifications with small tines and regular sanding of greens. The Sugarmill Woods irrigation is ready to hydrate those dry fairways and tees. In short, the turfgrass is ready to explode in growth, much like what we saw at Citrus National last year.

We hope that the membership is noticing the decrease in weeds, increased bunker maintenance and the much smoother back nine greens at Sugarmill Woods. Yes,

those zoysia greens continue to improve now that we have found that secret sauce of proper watering, cultural practices and less nutrients.

The Driving Range is also on our radar, so look for a more aggressive approach this spring including Command and fertilizer at both courses. As a reminder, the back tee area at Citrus is always available to Members. Enjoy that private area for practice.

Have you ever played in a Superintendents Revenge Tourney? A date will be set soon for this fun yet very strange golf event that you will not want to miss. I know the crew will enjoy setting up the course that day.

ORGANIZED PICKLEBALL GUIDELINES - SMW Oak Village Organized League Play or Group Play
Here are your guidelines to organize a team on a league that follows the pickleball and tennis rules set by SMW Oak Village management.

First the league must be presented and approved by OV management so courts can be reserved and work around club events that are scheduled.

Next the league must be advertised in the club newsletter so that all members have the opportunity to participate. Next all members of the team must be SMW OV members (for home and away matches) that play on the inter-club league that is playing at SMW and hosting neighboring reciprocating clubs.

The captain of the SMW Team must supply the team's schedule to include the number of courts needed, dates and times of match play. They are also responsible for clean up after the event.

Organized Group Play - Here are your guidelines for a day of any structured play following the pickleball and tennis rules set by SMW Oak Village management. First the activity must be presented and approved by OV management so courts can be reserved and work around club events that are scheduled.

Next the description of organized group play must be advertised in the club newsletter so that all members have the opportunity to participate. Next all members must be SMW OV member or fee guest of members (following the current guest policy*)

The organizer of the play is responsible for clean up after the event.

***Guest Policy for SMW Oak Village -** A local guest (player that lives within a 40 mile radius) must be reported by the member to Robin Frick and a daily guest fee of \$15.00 will be charged to your account. A local guest is limited to 6 visits per calendar year.


