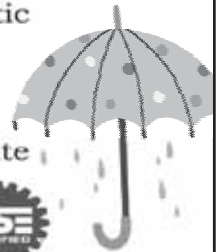

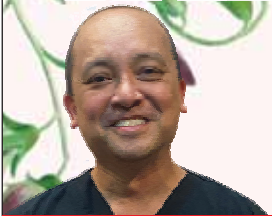

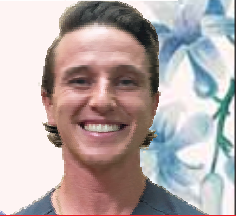

- Please use cart paths as much as practical staying on the paths until 90 degrees from your ball. This includes all four tires on the cart path along tees and greens. Golfers with handicaps are asked to approach greens from behind and never in between bunker and the green.

- Sugarmill Woods driving range closes on Sundays at 3pm and Citrus National closes Tuesday afternoons at 3pm for clean pick and maintenance.
- Dress code is enforced. Please advise guests that club rules do not allow tee shirts, jeans, short shorts or workout apparel. Country Club casual and respectful dress is required at all times.

Golf Tip of the Month

Can you waltz? 1-2-3, 1-2-3 as we move to the beat of the music. We all have our own unique swing quirks and shapes. Embrace your "move" and then find a rhythm that feels good to you. Consider hitting some balls at the range and hear yourself say one on the backswing, two on the way to the ball and three into and through to your finish position.

This also works with putting and chipping. While putting try hearing yourself say TIC on your backswing and TOC on your follow-through. Even saying a name works. Try TIGER on backswing and WOODS on contact. Forget the technical positions and find your rhythm.

The process continues to get Sugarmill Woods CC to achieve great course conditions. Mat O'Quinn and his team are laying the groundwork every day. The path is much like what the team accomplished at Citrus National last year. Irrigation repairs, weed control and followed up with proper maintenance practices. Aerify, fertilize, verticut, then repeat on tees, fairways and greens.

Citrus National before and after pictures are stunning. Last year at this time we had no grass on several tees and fairways. #2 green looked more like a bunker than a putting green. We are ready to reach the next level of course conditions. The current plan is to close Citrus National for the week of May 4th through the 10th for aggressive aerifications and fertilizer application. The Sugarmill Woods greens aerification will close Sugar May 18th through the 24th. Course closures may extend a few days depending on how the turf recovers.

The crew does their best to avoid interruption of golfers. Thank you to all the golfers for your patience as we work around play. If we hold you up from time to time, please know that we have your best interest in mind.

Big Kudos go out this month to our wonderful mechanics. Bobby and Roman are keeping us going with a true team effort. They are highly qualified from engines to turf equipment. We are super grateful for these guys.

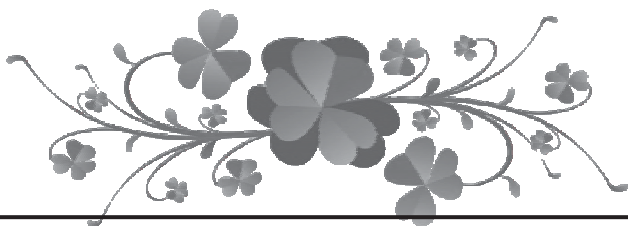

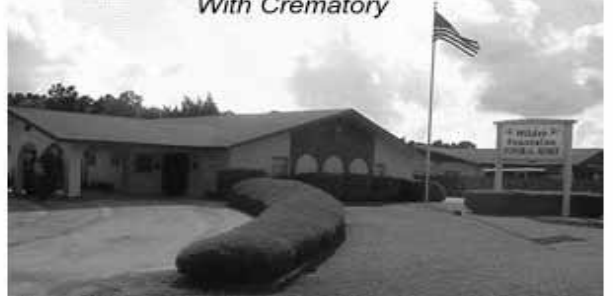

ORGANIZED PICKLEBALL GUIDELINES - SMW Oak Village Organized League Play or Group Play
Here are your guidelines to organize a team on a league that follows the pickleball and tennis rules set by SMW Oak Village management.

First the league must be presented and approved by OV management so courts can be reserved and work around club events that are scheduled.
Next the league must be advertised in the club newsletter so that all members have the opportunity to participate. Next all members of the team must be SMW OV members (for home and away matches) that play on the inter-club league that is playing at SMW and hosting neighboring reciprocating clubs.

The captain of the SMW Team must supply the team's schedule to include the number of courts needed, dates and times of match play. They are also responsible for clean up after the event.

Organized Group Play - Here are your guidelines for a day of any structured play following the pickleball and tennis rules set by SMW Oak Village management.
First the activity must be presented and approved by OV management so courts can be reserved and work around club events that are scheduled.
Next the description of organized group play must be advertised in the club newsletter so that all members have the opportunity to participate. Next all members must be SMW OV member or fee guest of members (following the current guest policy*).

The organizer of the play is responsible for clean up after the event.

***Guest Policy for SMW Oak Village -** A local guest (player that lives within a 40 mile radius) must be reported by the member to Robin Frick and a daily guest fee of \$15.00 will be charged to your account. A local guest is limited to 6 visits per calendar year.

A visiting temporary guest from outside a 40 mile radius must be reported without any guest fee charge incurred.
