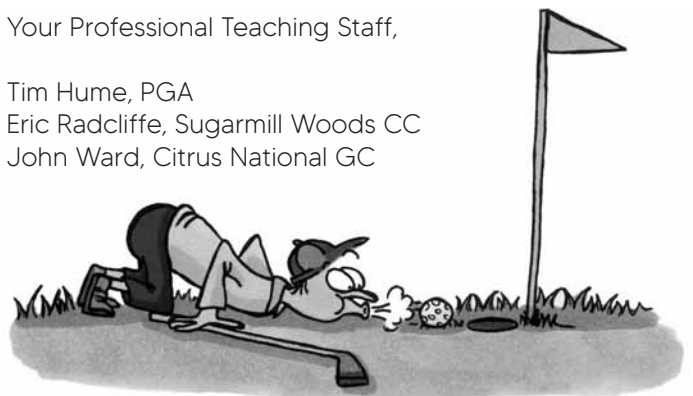
Golf Tip of the Month


Tim Hume says "Load and Hold" to hit solid shots from chipping to pitching to full swing. The LOAD refers to a natural hinging of the wrists during backswing. Then to get clubhead back to the ball for contact, hold the release as you power into the finish with your core/hips. Hinge back - Turn through, in short.

We like to flip the wrists at contact. We try to get under the ball at contact. Our bodies stop turning as hands and arms try to do all the work. Load and Hold to make these bad habits go away. Thanks Tim!

WE HAVE WATER!

As we learned from Citrus in 2025, nothing gets better until the water is under control. With Moisture levels improving, our team can apply herbicides, fertilizers and fight those pesky nematodes. “Getting rid of weeds is easy” once the water issues can be controlled.

Wall to wall fertilizer was applied last month at Citrus, (11.8 tons) and we are very happy with the progress. We found great Bermuda grass last year and 2026 is the summer to fill in nice and thick so that the ball sits on top of the grass. This thicker, more hearty stand will also help us survive next winter's cooler temps.

Citrus will be closing May 4th through the 8th for aerifying greens and applying more Command to fairs and Tees. Let's play Sugarmill this week and enjoy some great lunch specials after golf.

Sugarmill Woods will close May 18 through the 22nd for aerifying and fertilizing. Open for Hit & Giggle on the 22nd. Let's all play Citrus that week.

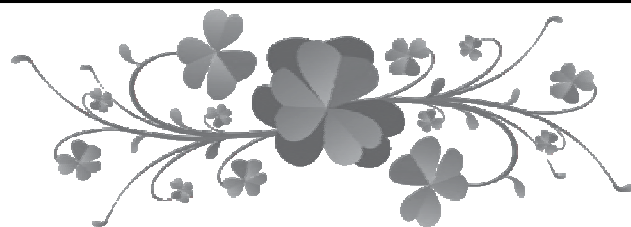

ORGANIZED PICKLEBALL GUIDELINES - SMW Oak Village Organized League Play or Group Play
Here are your guidelines to organize a team on a league that follows the pickleball and tennis rules set by SMW Oak Village management.

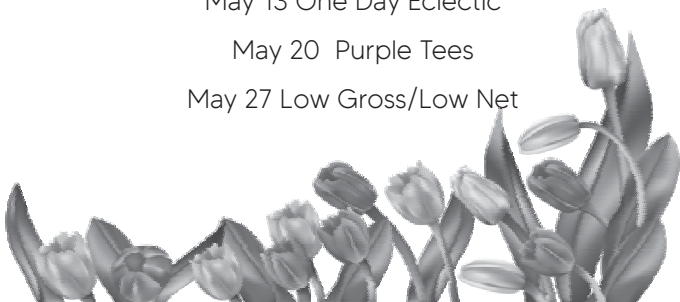
