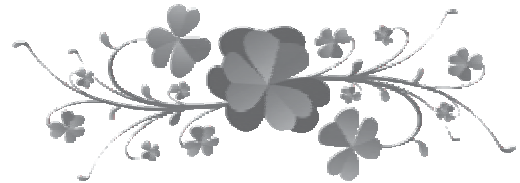

Golf Tip of the Month

To stay healthy and play better golf, hydrate before, during and after each round of golf.


The Harvard School of public health recommends 9 to 12 eight ounce servings of water is needed for proper health. Paired with a light, healthy breakfast before golf, it is best to drink a couple glasses of water before you tee off. Two to four 8 ounce cups during the round, two more after golf and four more before bedtime. As a golf staff, we recommend more 9 hole rounds and sports drinks high in electrolytes. Stay healthy and shoot lower scores.

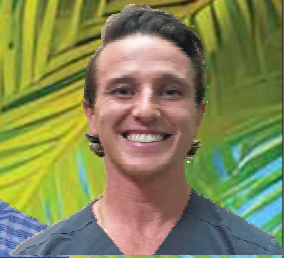

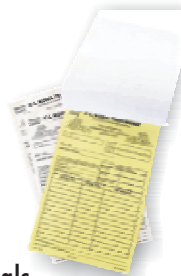
