At the writing on this article, the summer afternoon rains had not begun. Hopefully by the time that you read this, that will have changed.

Andy and his Sugarmill irrigation team continue to make progress, but a little rain would be appreciated. We now have regular water on several places that we haven't had water in years. Look for new turfgrass on #2 tee, #6 tee, #7 middle of fairway, #11, #13 & 14 tees, #15 & #17 fairways. Members should also be noticing the weed kill from the spring spray program. Strong, healthy turfgrass is now popping up in fairways and green surrounds.

Citrus is in full-blown growing season as we speak. The greens have fully recovered from the aggressive aeration in late May. Even the driving range floor is filling in nicely. We like to think that the driving range is our 19th fairway.

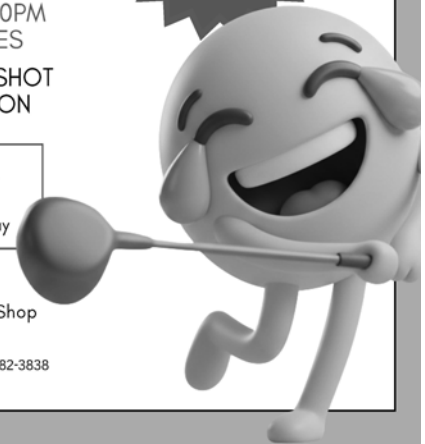
