Golf Tip of the Month

Josh Wiseman says to lower scores, start with chipping and pitching. Shots lost around the green make or break your day every time. The most common mistake we see is too much hands, wrists, and arms doing all the work. Let your chest, shoulders and hips flow through the stroke. Keep your chest turning through impact.

LINKS GOLF SUPERINTENDENT

The golf courses are making their move. Although in different stages, both courses are shaping up nicely in preparation for the upcoming season. We are seeing progress in weed control as herbicide programs continue. With new equipment, the rolling of greens is creating a much smoother surface for putting.

We have started using a new (for us) chemical called Primo. Primo is actually a growth regulator that restricts vertical growth and promotes lateral growth and root health. This is good as the turfgrass will grow thicker which raises your golf ball slightly off the ground and helps the turf withstand stress. In the past two years, Primo was not recommended as we needed any kind of turfgrass that we could find. Now that our Bermuda has filled in, the goal is to make it thick and strong.

We have begun the process of looking into a new irrigation system at Sugarmill. Details to follow.

Improvement Projects

Bob Schneider has been a busy guy helping with repairs around the club. He has fixed the center strap anchor on court #6 and fixed the center strap on court #4. He has methodically been addressing and fixing some of the stubborn "flossers", (line brushes). It's great that he thinks outside the box and is able to repair things. **Many thanks, Bob!!**

What the Heck?! "TYPTI"???

TYPTI (pronounced "Tip-tee") is a fast-growing hybrid racquet sport created by Tennis Channel founder Steve Bellamy. It is played on a pickleball court and replaces the loud paddles and hard plastic ball of pickleball. We use 22" strung racquet and a quiet 3.5-inch channeled foam ball. The sport is designed for long rallies and requires no overhead serves.

It is supported by high-profile investors like Drew Brees and broadcast on the tennis channel, TYPTI is making major waves in the racquet community. It was featured on the front page of Racquet Sports Magazine a few months ago.

The racquet is a specialized 22" strung, slightly smaller than the standard tennis frame but larger than the pickleball paddle.

The ball is a large 3.5" channeled foam ball that is unlike the hard plastic of pickleball, this ball is nearly noiseless, eliminating the common noise complaints associated with the pickleball courts. The unique channeling allows players to control depth, trajectory, and apply heavy spin.

There are some distinct differences from the sports of tennis, badminton and pickleball.

- No "kitchen" ...you can crash the net!
- No overhead serve...much easier to sustain longer rallies.
- Smart Scoring ...a unique system that marries risk and reward.
- Live netted balls ...netted balls can remain live in play promoting longer strategic rallies.

The sports major advantage is it can be played on pickleball courts. The soft impact from the foam ball is very easy on the joints and produces NO noise. It is rapidly professionalizing featuring a pro division with \$100,000 in total prize money.

Bottom Line: It is easy to play and the rules and scoring is simple.

Super Drill for All Ages

This active and intense workout meets twice a week every week throughout the year. Everyone warms up with the usual forehand, backhand....and then things really start moving with game based drills. Players should be able to keep the ball in play. This drill is recommended for USTA 3.0+ rated players and above. Age is not a factor. We have AARP passes that will be given to our older players.

ORGANIZED PICKLEBALL GUIDELINES

SMW Oak Village Organized League Play or Group Play

Here are your guidelines to organize a team on a league that follows the pickleball and tennis rules set by SMW Oak Village management.

First the league must be presented and approved by OV management so courts can be reserved and work around club events that are scheduled. Next the league must be advertised in the club newsletter so that all members have the opportunity to participate. Next all members of the team must be SMW OV members (for home and away matches) that play on the inter-club league that is playing at SMW and hosting neighboring reciprocating clubs.

The captain of the SMW Team must supply the team's schedule to include the number of courts needed, dates and times of match play. They are also responsible for clean up after the event.

Organized Group Play

Here are your guidelines for a day of any structured play following the pickleball and tennis rules set by SMW Oak Village management.

First the activity must be presented and approved by OV management so courts can be reserved and work around club events that are scheduled.

Next the description of organized group play must be advertised in the club newsletter so that all members have the opportunity to participate.

Next all members must be SMW OV member or fee guest of members (following the current guest policy*)

The organizer of the play is responsible for reporting non-member attendees (collection of guest fees) and cleaning up after the event.

***Guest Policy for SMW Oak Village**

A local guest (player that lives within a 40 mile radius) must be reported by the member to Robin Frick and a daily guest fee of \$15.00 will be charged to your account. A local guest is limited to 6 visits per calendar year.

A visiting temporary guest from outside a 40 mile radius must be reported without any guest fee charge incurred.

Pickleball Stroke of the Week Clinic

This is a weekly pickleball clinic that meets every Friday from 10:30 to 11:30AM at the Oak Village Sports Complex on Pickleball courts #7 and #8. Beginners to intermediate level players attend to work on skills and tactics that help improve their playing abilities.

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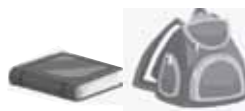

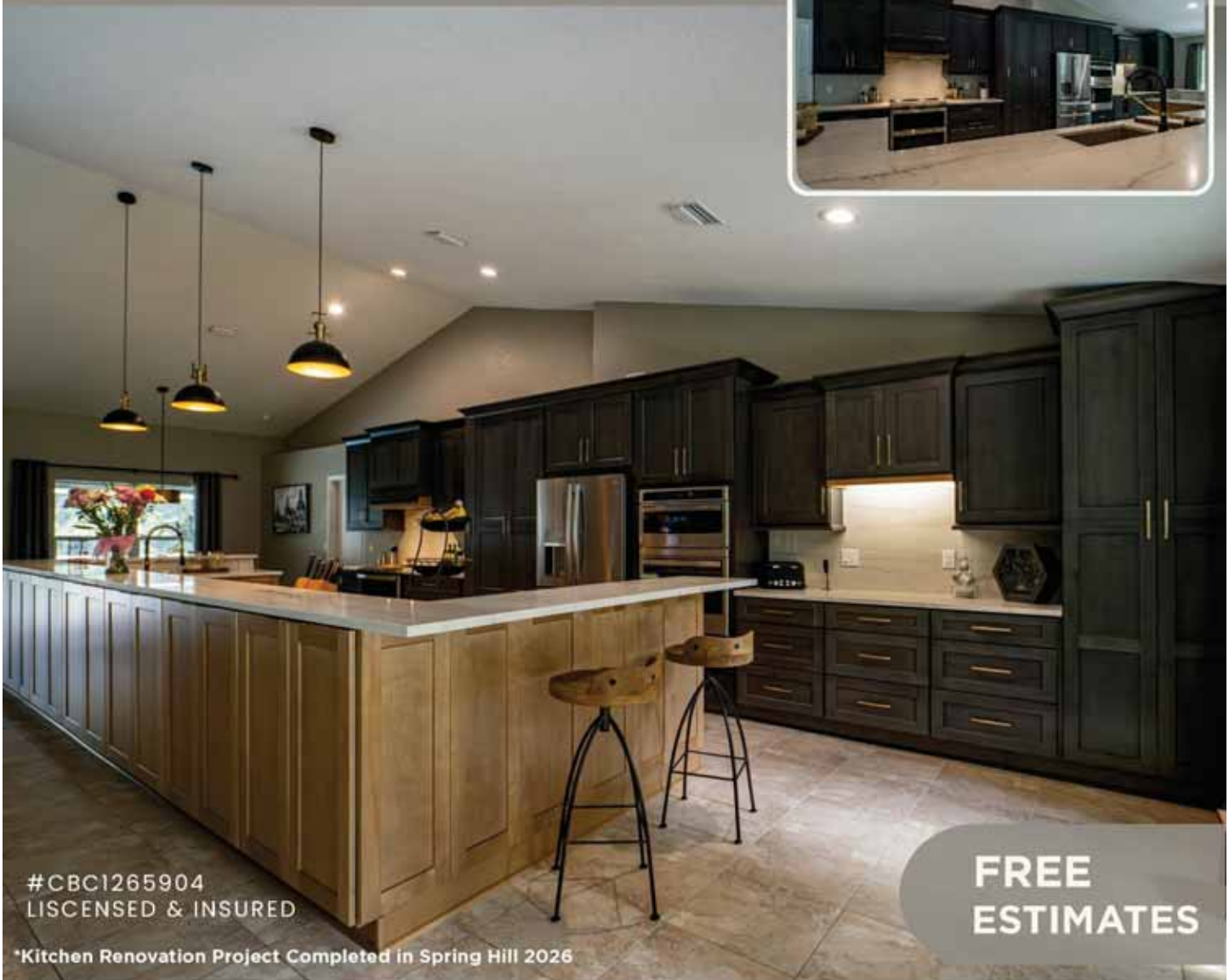

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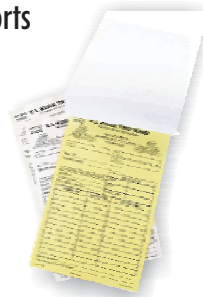
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
