performance is almost here. Rough mowers, greens mowers, sand pros and maybe even a new tractor will give our team high-quality machinery to maintain the courses. Adding the Greens Roller earlier this summer did wonders for the Citrus greens. We also have two new zero turn mowers zooming around all the trees while mowing their little hearts out.

Are you a Leapfrogger?

Leapfrogger is the new term for golfers playing a more forward tee, driving around their playing companions to get to their tee box. I play the blue tees. You play the whites and the other two in our group play the greens. The "Green Guys" drive around us after we hit. In the future, as a Club, we kindly ask the golfers playing the more forward tees to pass on the far side of the path. If the tee box is left of the path, pass on the right. If the tee box is on the right side of the path, pass on the left. This will help us grow grass along the tee boxes. Make Sense?

Clinics and a new Kids After School Program are starting soon at Sugarmill Woods CC with Eric Radcliffe. Dates and times are posted in the Golf Shop. Lessons are also available at Citrus National with Josh Wiseman. Both of our pros are accomplished golfers and offer a simplistic approach to lower your score. Making each golfer swing like Tiger Woods is not the goal. Finding the best way for each individual golfer to get the most out of their swing is paramount.

Golf Tip of the Month (Magic Move)

The downswing starts "before" the backswing ends. You heard it right, before the shoulders and arms have completed their motion away from the ball, hips need to start shifting with weight moving towards target. Call this your magic move. It will be a little tricky at first and you may need help from an accomplished instructor. Tour players do it and the rest of us don't.

What the Heck?! "TYPTI"??? TYPTI (pronounced "Tip-tee") is a fast-growing hybrid racquet sport created by Tennis Channel founder Steve Bellamy. It is played on a pickleball court and replaces the loud paddles and hard plastic ball of pickleball. We use 22" strung racquet and a quiet 3.5-inch channeled foam ball. The sport is designed for long rallies and requires no overhead serves.

It is supported by high-profile investors like Drew Brees and broadcast on the tennis channel, TYPTI is making major waves in the racquet community. It was featured on the front page of Racquet Sports Magazine a few months ago.

The racquet is a specialized 22" strung, slightly smaller than the standard tennis frame but larger than the pickleball paddle.

The ball is a large 3.5" channeled foam ball that is unlike the hard plastic of pickleball, this ball is nearly noiseless,

eliminating the common noise complaints associated with the pickleball courts. The unique channeling allows players to control depth, trajectory, and apply heavy spin.

There are some distinct differences from the sports of tennis, badminton and pickleball.

- No "kitchen" ...you can crash the net!
- No overhead serve...much easier to sustain longer rallies.
- Smart Scoring ...a unique system that marries risk and reward.
- Live netted balls ...netted balls can remain live in play promoting longer strategic rallies.

The sports major advantage is it can be played on pickleball courts. The soft impact from the foam ball is very easy on the joints and produces NO noise. It is rapidly professionalizing featuring a pro division with \$100,000 in total prize money.

Bottom Line: It is easy to play and the rules and scoring is simple.
