

#### **Green Side Up!**

The push for great course conditions continues at both courses. Mat & Andy continue to address upgrades in irrigation and weed control. Pushing the Bermuda grass to grow in the winter is slow but does happen. Thank you in advance for following posted cart rules and using cart paths as much as practical. Both courses have settled into routines with weekly weed control applications and adding nutrients through fertilizer programs. Tree work and training of staffs also continues.

Have you noticed the steady progress with the back nine Sugarmill greens? We now mow each nine at a different height of cut and with a different mower. The goal is to get the green speeds matching on each side. The back nine Zoysia grass tends to be a little slower so that height of cut will be lower.

To overseed or not to overseed is always a hot topic. We will not be overseeding any greens this year. Look for smooth and fast greens this winter. Color is overrated. Smooth rolling greens is the goal and each crew is ready to make that happen. Rye grass overseeding will be mainly on tees, weak fairways and the range for 2025 season.

Shhh, each course has applied pre-emerge herbicide. That means less weeds next spring as we come out of winter. Save this newsletter and let's assess our weed control in May of 2025.



### LOTS of Exciting Things are Happening at Oak Village Sports Complex...

#### **Pickleball Third Shot - Drop or Drive**

You just served the pickleball to your opponent and they returned the ball in play. This is now the 3rd shot and, for the serving team, it is the most important shot of the rally. If you make a good third shot, it will cancel the positional advantage of the receiving team. So, you know you need to make a good third shot but you have a choice. Do you hit a third shot drop or a third shot drive?

We know the serving team is at a disadvantage before they take the third shot because the other team is probably already at the kitchen. The serving team has to sit back and wait for the return to bounce before the third shot can be made. So, when do we use a drop and when do we use a drive?

**Choosing between a drop or drive.** Is a third shot drop or a third shot drive a better shot? You can't say outright because there are several scenarios that you could consider before making your shot choice. Some factors that should influence your choice include:

- 1) How are your opponents positioned on the court?
- 2) What type of return did they make on your serve?
- 3) What are the abilities of your opponents?

#### When to Choose Third Shot Drive

#### The return of your serve is short and bounces high.

If your opponent mis-hits your serve and returns it short, especially if you get a bounce above the knee, this is a great opportunity to drive the ball. Not only does it allow you to build momentum as you move to the ball, you can continue that movement to quickly get to the kitchen. Also, if you drive the ball on a short return, there is less time for your opponent to react, increasing his opportunity to make an error while hitting the ball.

**The opposing team is out of position.** If you've made your serve and it either pulled your opponent off to the side or they returned it and stayed back, you have a great opportunity to drive the ball. In this case, if you

hit a third shot drop, the slowness of the drop will allow them to recover. If you've pulled them out to the side, a drive to the area that was left open is a good choice. And, if they returned your serve and stayed back, a drive to their feet will keep them from moving forward and allow you to get up to the kitchen.

Your opponents are weak at the net. If you suspect your opponents have weak blocking skills or weak or inaccurate volleys, a drive is also a good choice. If you get a drivable ball, take the drive and force your opponents to play to their weaknesses.

#### When to Choose Third Shot Drop.

### Your opponent returns your serve deep into your court. Drives work because of speed on the ball and

**court.** Drives work because of speed on the ball and the little time your opponent has to react to your shot. If you hit your drive from the baseline, the ball will be much slower when it reaches your opponent and they will have plenty of time to get ready. In this case, a slow, well placed drop will help you and your partner get to the kitchen.

Your opponents have a strong net game. Players that are very good at volleying even fast drives and are very proficient at blocking will be hard to force into errors by driving the ball at them. If their net game is strong, they can cause problems for you and your partner by returning hard, low drives back to you. In this case, limit their ability to attack by dropping a ball into the kitchen allowing you and your partner to move up.

#### The return of your serve is short but bounces low.

Just because the return is short doesn't mean you'll be able to drive it. If the bounce is below the knee because of spin or because you can't get to the ball in time, you'll have to hit up on the ball to clear the net. If you hit it up and hard, it's likely to go off the back of the court. If you hit it up and soft, you'll likely get an overhead drive hit back at you. Instead, an unattackable drop into the kitchen allows you to wait for a better opportunity to setup an attack.

As you can see, there are situations when a drive is advantageous and there are times when a drop is better suited. Use the situations discussed above to help you decide which to hit. In any case, don't become predictable. While these situations should help you decide, they aren't cast in stone rules. Be flexible and have fun.




